ADDRESS OF THE NEW PRESIDENT

Drage kolegice, spoštovani kolegi geodeti.

Ob izidu zadnje številke Geodetskega vestnika v letu 2020 vas prav lepo pozdravljam kot novi predsednik Zveze geodetov Slovenije.

Okoliščine, povezane z epidemijo covid, v katerih smo se znašli letos marca, žal še kar trajajo in močno vplivajo na naše življenje in delo. Vse skupaj nas zagotovo ne pušča ravnodušnih. Vsak na svojem področju delovanja v geodetski stroki se ukvarjamo z veliko vprašanji, eno ključnih pa je zagotovo – kako in na kakšen način naprej. Ne glede na to sem prepričan, da je v nas geodetih obilo optimizma in odločnosti s pozitivnim pogledom naprej. Kot novi predsednik bi izpostavil nekaj ključnih izhodišč svojega programa dela v naslednjem mandatnem obdobju.

Geodezija, kot izrazito tehnično interdisciplinarna stroka, ima v vseh razvitih državah ključno vlogo pri razvoju prostorske podatkovne infrastrukture in urejanju prostora. Stopnja družbenega in političnega zavedanja o pomembnosti geodezije je v Sloveniji zagotovo na prenizki ravni. Vse prepogosto je geodezija nekaj samoumevnega, premalo se zavedamo odgovornosti in njene vloge. Obvladovanje prostora je ena ključnih nalog države, saj je njen konstitutivni element. Prostor in z njim povezana lastnina sta najvišji obliki ustavne kategorije, zato jo je treba ustrezno varovati. In pri tem imamo geodeti ključno vlogo. Tega se včasih premalo zavedamo oziroma ne znamo tega jasno in odločno povedati v družbi.

Moj program dela bo temeljil na naslednjih ključnih temah:

- izdelava strategije geodetske stroke v tesnem sodelovanju vseh strokovnih subjektov;
- predlog reorganizacije ZGS v smislu njenega učinkovitejšega dela z namenom boljšega in ciljno usmerjenega izkoristka vseh resursov (strokovni subjekti, posamezniki), ki bo zagotavljal najvišjo mogočo stopnjo razvoja geodetske stroke. Predlagal bom celovito razpravo, kako to doseči, tudi s predlogom glede polne ali delne zaposlitve, funkcije direktorja ali druge organizacijske oblike;
- ustanovitev komisij po področjih geodetske stroke in koordiniranje njihovega aktivnega dela, tako bi se tudi Geodetski dnevi organizirali po posameznih področjih komisij, s prilagojenimi temami osrednje teme;
- ZGS mora postati ključno stičišče med zasebnim in javnim sektorjem geodezije;
- aktivno delo, sodelovanje z drugimi strokami, ministrstvi, javnimi organi in politiko;
- ZGS mora prevzeti pomembnejšo vlogo pri sprejemanju zakonodaje;

- vzpostavitev aktivnega stika z javnostjo (PR) z namenom dviga prepoznavnosti delovanja ter pomena geodetske stroke v družbi in politiki. Poudarek na sodelovanju z mediji;
- podpora vsem dosedanjim ključnim aktivnostim ZGS, kot so izdajanje Geodetskega vestnika, organizacija Geodetskih dnevov, strokovna srečanja.

Za dosego zastavljenega programa delaje ključen način vodenja in sodelovanja med vsemi subjekti v okviru delovanja ZGS. Drugače, ključna je vizija vodenja ZGS. V praksi se velikokrat izkaže, da je odsotnost prave vizije vodenja ključni razlog za neuresničitev programa dela in s tem napredka. Osebn nisem obremenjen s stvarmi iz preteklosti, osebnimi in strokovnimi nesoglasji. Moja vizija vodenja ZGS bo temeljila na aktivnem sodelovanju vseh deležnikov za najvišje dobro geodetske stroke. K aktivnemu sodelovanju bom pozval vse člane v vseh geodetskih društvih in zaposlene pri vseh strokovnih subjektih. Povabil jih bom, da se vključijo v delo komisij pri ZGS, strokovne razprave, odnose z javnostmi in dogodke ZGS. Prizadeval si bom za aktivnejšo vlogo mlajših geodetskih strokovnjakov. Glede na dejstva in dosedanje izkušnje pri delu na področju geodezije smo bili dostikrat geodeti sami sebi največja ovira za konkretniji napredek stroke, saj nismo zmogli dovolj visoke stopnje medsebojnega sodelovanja in ustreznega razumevanja. Pogosto nam primanjkuje tudi samospoštovanja in sposobnosti sodelovanja z drugimi strokami. Prizadeval si bom, da nas drugačna razmišljanja ne bodo delila, ampak nas povezovala, saj je le tako mogoč napredek stroke. Ključno bo tudi sodelovanje s sorodnimi strokami, s posebnim poudarkom, da na področju urejanja prostora prevzamemo pomembnejšo vlogo.

Vse to znamo in zmoremo ustrezno izpeljati v prihodnje, če bo naše delo temeljilo na medsebojnem sodelovanju in uresničevanju ciljev, ki jih moramo jasno opredeliti v strategiji geodetske stroke na vseh področjih našega delovanja. Vabim vas, da postanete še dejavnejši na svojih področjih delovanja, ter s svojimi izkušnjami, predlogi in pobudami soustvarite boljši jutri slovenske geodezije. Iskreno se zahvaljujem vsem svojim predhodnikom in vsem, ki v geodeziji puščate neizbrisen pečat.

May I take the last issue of Geodetski vestnik in 2020 as an opportunity to greet you as of the President of the Association of Surveyors of Slovenia?

The COVID-19 epidemic that broke out in March this year stubbornly persists and gravely affects our working and private lives. It is becoming increasingly difficult to remain impassive in the developing situation. Land-surveying professionals have been dealing with several issues in their respective fields, the fundamental one undoubtedly being how to continue. Despite all obstacles, I am confident that plenty of optimism and resolve, with a positive outlook, still thrive in the land-surveying profession. As the new president, I would like to sketch out some key points from my work programme for the next mandate.

In all developed countries, land surveying, as a technical and an essentially interdisciplinary profession, features prominently in the development of spatial data infrastructure and spatial management. In Slovenia, we are undoubtedly encountered with a lack of social and political awareness of the importance of land surveying. Far too often, it is considered as something self-evident; people are not sufficiently acquainted with its responsibilities and role. Space is the constituent element of any country, and its management is one of the key tasks of any

state. Space and the right to property derived from it are the highest constitutional categories, so they should be protected accordingly. Land surveyors have a key role to play here. Sometimes we are not fully aware of the fact and are unable to stress its importance publicly.

My work programme focuses on the following central themes:

- *to prepare a strategic document on land surveying in close cooperation between all entities in the profession;*
- *a proposal for the reorganisation of the association to enhance its efficiency with the aim of a better and more targeted deployment of all its resources (professional entities, individuals), which will in turn enable the highest possible stage of the development of land surveying. I will endeavour to promote a comprehensive debate on how to reach these goals, along with a proposal to create a position of a full-time or part-time employed director, or some other organisational form if necessary;*
- *to establish commissions for various land-surveying fields and to coordinate their activities, which also means that the concept of Land Surveying Days would be based on their respective fields of work, with themes relevant to the governing theme;*
- *to make the association the central meeting point of public and private land-surveying sectors;*
- *to enhance active work, cooperation with other professions, ministries, public bodies and politics;*
- *to make the association an active player in the legislative process;*
- *to cultivate relations with the public (PR) to raise the visibility of the land-surveying profession, with its activities and relevance for society and policies;*
- *to support already existing main activities of the association, such as the publication of Geodetski vestnik, the organisation of Land Surveying Days, professional meetings.*

The work programme calls for an essential way of management and cooperation between all entities involved in the activities of the association. In other words, a leadership vision is of key importance for the association. It has been proven many times that the absence of a clear leadership vision is the main reason for unsuccessful work programmes and the resulting lack of development. I am not bothered by personal and professional disputes. My leadership vision for the association will build on the active cooperation of all involved parties to seek the greatest good in the surveying profession. I will call for active cooperation of all members in surveying societies and employees in professional entities. They will be invited to contribute to the work of commissions in the association, to professional discussions, public relations and events organised by the association. I will strive for a more active role of young surveying professionals. Considering some facts and existing experience, one could conclude that land surveyors themselves have proved to be their own obstacle for a more rapid development of their profession, as they were not able to establish a sufficiently high level of cooperation and understanding. It is often the case that we lack sufficient self-respect and the ability to cooperate with other professions. I will endeavour that different views not divide us but connect us as this is the only assurance of professional advancement. Cooperation with related professions is also key, emphasising that we take on a more active role in space management.

We have the knowledge and the abilities to do so if our work is founded on cooperation and striving for goals that should be clearly defined in the professional strategy in all areas of land surveying. You are invited to become even more active in your respective fields, and to share your experience, proposals and incentives for the brighter tomorrow of land surveying in Slovenia. I wish to express many heartfelt thanks to my predecessors and all of you who leave a permanent mark on land surveying.
